### **HERS Summer Institutes**

These are residential training opportunities which prepare participants to work with issues currently facing higher education. The first one is held on the campus of the University of Denver in Colorado in June and the second on the campus Bryn Mawr College in Pennsylvania in July. The institute seeks to improve the status of women in the middle and executive levels of higher education administration.

### **IUPUI Tradition**

IUPUI has sent 46 women faculty and staff members to this prestigious institute since 1987. At least half of those continue to work at IUPUI in leadership capacities. It is a wonderful opportunity to prepare for administrative leadership positions and develop a national and international network of colleagues plus focus on your professional development. Any full-time faculty or staff member may apply for the IUPUI funding.

## **IUPUI Funding**

The Office for Women coordinates the campus application process for candidates seeking IUPUI funding to this national training. Executive Vice Chancellor Nasser Paydar has committed some funding to provide a match for a departmental candidate in 2015. *The department will be responsible for one-half of the tuition.*

## **IUPUI Application Process**

Interested candidates for the IUPUI funding should prepare a **letter** identifying your immediate professional objective and the path you would like your career to take and outlining how you think attendance at the Institute will help you achieve your objectives. (Please note that the final application to HERS requires two letters of support. One will be from the Chancellor and the second must be from your direct supervisor or sponsor.)

Send this *letter and a copy of your CV/Resume* to Kathleen Grove, Director, IUPUI Office for Women, [ksgrove@iupui.edu](mailto:ksgrove@iupui.edu) by **Wednesday, February 11<sup>th</sup>**.

Current HERS institute alums on campus screen candidates and make recommendations regarding the selection. Once a candidate has been selected, the Office for Women will assist the candidate in completing the online application and gathering the appropriate recommendation letters.
